


### Drug Samples

We test participant drug samples to give them information about what is in the drugs they purchased and how much it aligns with what they intend to buy. In May 2025, we tested 22 samples and received results for 21 of them.

The chart below compares drugs expected to the drug detected during testing, for 21 samples.

- **Left of the dotted line:** the drug expected was detected, with or without other drugs present.
- **Right of the dotted line:** the drug expected was absent, with or without other drugs present.



### Drug Paraphernalia

We check drug paraphernalia to get additional insights into the drug supply. In May 2025, we tested 31 total paraphernalia and received results for 22 of them.

9 syringes




1 baggie



1 straw

#### Most Common Drugs Detected\*

(Drugs were found in 19 of 22 samples; some samples contained multiple drugs.)



\*Drugs detected only one time included heroin (straw), albuterol (pipe), THC (pipe), xylazine (straw), and synthetic cathinone (straw)

### Key Highlights for May 2025

#### Drug Sample Take-aways:

- 76% of samples contained only the sold as drug.
- 1 heroin sample also contained cocaine; 1 fentanyl sample also contained lidocaine.
- Both samples sold as Xanax contained only other benzodiazepines (Bromazolam and Phenazolam).

#### Paraphernalia Take-aways:

- Methamphetamine was the drug most commonly detected in paraphernalia and was found in 6 pipes, 3 syringes, and 1 straw.
- 7 unique substances were detected in just 1 straw, suggesting paraphernalia may be used for multiple drugs or people.
