


Drug Samples

We test participant drug samples to give them information about what is in the drugs they purchased and how much it aligns with what they intend to buy. In June 2025, we tested 38 total drug samples and received results for 35 of them.

The chart below lists what drug samples were "sold as." We are still processing the extent to which the "sold as" drug matched the drug detected through FTIR, though we include some of these findings in call-out boxes below.

What drug samples were sold as



"House blend" was brought to us during our outreach.

- Our participants explained to us that this is leftovers from the table where drugs are weighed out and would contain a mixture of substances and compounds.
- Results showed that "house blend" contained cocaine, ketamine, and methamphetamine.
- This is a new term for us and we will be on the look out for this in the future

Drug Paraphernalia

We check drug paraphernalia to get additional insights into the drug supply. In June 2025, we tested 19 total paraphernalia. Results are still being organized.

Paraphernalia Types Tested



15 pipes



2 syringes



2 baggies

Two samples sold as **heroin** contained heroin along with cocaine, though the cocaine was in relatively low (and possible insignificant) amounts.

One of our participants gave us a sample that was sold as **heroin**, but it contained additional compounds (**fentanyl, cocaine, methamphetamine**) in relatively small amounts (<10%).

- We talked with the participant and explained our findings.
- We discussed the potential health implications of the results and gave the participant harm reduction information and supplies (Narcan, test strips, etc.).
